Hire Rates – As from 1st September 2021

Our main hall is 11m x 6m. The hall contains tables and chairs and has a hard polished floor.

The Community Room is 6.5m x 5m. It contains tables and chairs and a large flat screen TV Monitor (with no access to broadcast TV).

There is also a common foyer with access to a kitchen, toilets (including disabled) and a shower room. The whole building is covered by high-speed internet with controlled guest access.

Party bookings

Children’s Parties are priced at £60 for 2 hours with 30 minutes set-up and clear-away either side. Parties are available on Saturday and Sunday afternoons at 12-3PM and 3-6PM.

Saturday Evenings are priced at £150 for 6PM – 11:30PM. Set-up and clear-away times are included in the overall times.

Saturday all day bookings are priced at £300 for 12 Noon – 11:30PM. Please get in touch if you require different hours. Set-up and clear-away times are included in the overall times.

Please note that music must not be played after 11PM.

Note: Party bookings include access to the whole building, kitchen and grounds.

Other bookings

Rates for other users depends on the type of use:

Non-profit means events that are open to the public where no profit is generated by the hirer, or any profits go to charity.

Commercial means events that are open to the public and run to generate a profit.

Private means business use, meetings etc. where the event is not open to the public.
